INDEPENDENCE DAY/SUMMER PARTIES

Having a summer or 4th of July party? Please remember to follow the rules and regulations and keep the noise level down. Be courteous to your neighbors during this holiday.

FIREWORKS ARE ILLEGAL

The Corona Municipal Code prohibits the sale, use, discharge, and possession of fireworks within the City limits.

The max penalty for "Safe and Sane" fireworks has been increased from up to five hundred dollars (\$500) to up to one thousand dollars (\$1,000) and illegal fireworks from up to one thousand dollars (\$1,000) to five thousand dollars (\$5,000). Avoid the Fines.

NEW LANDSCAPE VENDOR

Park West is the new Landscape vendor for Butterfield Estates as of June 1, 2022. They have been trimming the trees and removing some of the overgrown brush.

RODENT PROTECTION IN THE COMMUNITY

Don't plant ivy it provides shelter and a food source for rodents: snails and slugs. Ivy on walls can form "rat ladders" to windows, attics and other interior spaces.

Keep compost piles as far away from structures as possible and cut grass to no more than two inches tall.

Maintain at least a 2-foot space between bushes, shrubs, fences, and buildings. Also, remove tree limbs within 3 feet of a structure or roof.

Avoid having a bird feeder since it provides a source of food for rodents.

PROPERTY MAINTENANCE

The purpose of rules regarding property maintenance is to help the Association set a standard for how properties should be maintained. This helps keep up property values which benefits all homeowners. With this said, the we would like to point out some of the common maintenance items that homeowners may receive a letter for:

- Weeds in the planters, driveway cracks or turf. Keep in mind that if you turn down your irrigation on your lawn to conserve water, you may find that weeds still grow.
 Weeds require far less water than turf and as your turf turns brown, the tall green weeds tend to stand out. We recommend monitoring your turf and spraying and pulling weeds as necessary.
- Trash cans should be taken in after trash day and stored behind your gate. This is pretty self explanatory. Please find a spot to store your trash cans behind your gate and bring them in the night of trash pick up.
- Address Numbers should not be covered up by any decorative flags, light fixtures or landscaping such as ivy or shrubs. It is a good idea to have your address numbers readily visible should any emergency vehicles (fire, ambulance or police) need to locate your house in an emergency. Seconds can count!
- Items stored in the front or side yard. There should be no items stored in the front or side yard.
